We hosted an open forum with the Assistant Commissioner in Charge Of Road Policing which proved very successful in clarifying how the Queensland Police Service interpret our road policing laws and regulations. Hosting this forum enabled QMSC to established itself as a sounding board for the Queensland Police Service and their implementation of new road rules and regulations.

QMSC Ambassador John Goss organised a petition to the Queensland Government to help secure tenure of motor sport facilities. The public response to this petition of more than 17,000 was commendable and proved beyond doubt the people for whom QMSC advocate are passionate and serious about their recreational motorised activities.

Vice President – Chris Malone has done an outstanding job representing all forms of motoring enthusiasts at the Motor Organisations and Car Clubs Committee (MOCCC) on a monthly basis. The MOCCC is under the auspices of the Department of Transport and Main Roads and provides a direct link between motor sports and the department. This work is vitally important if motoring enthusiasts are to have input into vehicle standards including modifications, special interest vehicles (SIV) and the application of vehicle and transport regulations.

Members of the QMSC Board are actively lobbying State politicians to ensure, in the lead up to the 2015 state election, the government recognise **motor activities enthusiasts contribute to a large and legitimate sector of the economy and provide social networks for all involved.**
